

COUNTER NOTICE (TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICE)

Counter Notice (Temporary Event Notice) – Permitted Temporary Activities

On Thursday, 31st March 2022, the Licensing Authority received from you, COLIN BERESFORD, (of Euphoria Festivals Limited), a Temporary Event Notice (“the notice”) in respect of proposed temporary licensable activities proposed to take place on Saturday, 20th August 2022, in a field at Darley Moor Racing Club, Darley Moor Airfield, Darley Moor, off the A515, Ashbourne, DE6 2ET.

The Licensing Authority received an Objection Notice under section 104(2) of the Licensing Act (“the Act”).

During the 3 working day consultation period, which expired on Tuesday 5th April 2022, the Licensing Authority received an Objection Notice from:


On Tuesday, 5th April 2022, an Objection Notice was received from the Council’s Environmental Health Department, on the grounds that the prevention of public nuisance and public safety licensing objectives would be undermined if the Darley Dance Festival event was allowed to take place at this location.

The Objection Notice was not withdrawn, and on Thursday 14th April 2022, at 2pm, a licensing hearing was held to consider whether or not the Council’s Environmental Health Department’s Objection Notice should be accepted by the Council’s Licensing and Appeals Sub-Committee.

The Sub-Committee **RESOLVED:**

To accept the objection from the Environmental Health Department and instructed the Licensing Manager to serve a Counter Notice on the ‘premises user’, regarding this event.

The reasons for the decision are given in the attached Decision Notice, included in the Minutes of the Licensing and Appeals Sub-Committee Meeting.
