I wish to make a further objection to the neighbourhood plan (however online form allows only one comment.)

Regarding Section P2 Protecting Views

1) The photos used have been taken in a very subjective way and are not unbiased for example

View 7 and 13 has new developments either side of the view point and could be argued that the view has already been destroyed by recent adjacent domestic developments.

View 12 has now an Agricultural barn - yet again destroying this view

View 10 - close examination of this view shows the 1960's bungalow made out of reconstituted stone (not local natural stone) - and has already been destroyed, further a rotation of 180 degrees brings the sports court into view, developed on open land.

In general it could be argued that the inclusion of these photos should be subject to the relevant land owners giving their permission, because the use of such images is not for personal use, rather a use that is related to a

more commercial nature. I suggest any photos taken on private land, even from the view point of a public right of way be deleted or consent sort for their usage.
