I have lived at [REDACTED] & my main concern is the great increase in traffic using Old Hackney Lane now & in the future.

The following points need urgent consideration:-

1. Exit by car from the Darley House Estate onto Old Hackney Lane becomes more & more hazardous, as vehicles speed off the A6.
2. How about a weight restriction notice on commercial vehicles using Old Hackney Lane?
3. Also a 'Stop' sign instead of a 'Give Way' sign where OHL joins A6.
4. At the narrow bend (near the Cactus Nursery), suggest permanent traffic lights. Due to the present building work there, the temporary traffic lights are making this area much less of a hazard. When the 217 bus is diverted down OHL, due to road works on Hackney Road/Greenaway Lane, traffic lights would help. Also there are shrubs overhanging the wall at this point which obscure the sight line.

I would like to be kept informed of any decisions made about this area.
