

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980.
DERBYSHIRE DALES DISTRICT COUNCIL

DERBYSHIRE DALES DISTRICT COUNCIL (Public Footpath No. 9, Mercaston) Public Path
Diversion Order 2020

On 19th October 2021 Derbyshire Dales District Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from point A, Ordnance Survey ("OS") Grid Reference SK 27720 42396, in a north-easterly direction for 91 metres to point B, OS Grid Reference SK 27793 42450, then continuing in an east-north-easterly direction for 66 metres to point C, OS Grid Reference SK 27857 42464 to a length of public footpath with a natural surface running from point E, OS Grid Reference SK 27707 42407, in an east-north-easterly direction for 122 metres to point D, grid reference SK 27827 42424, then continuing in a north-easterly direction for 49 metres to point C, OS Grid Reference SK 27857 42464, as shown on the order map.

The order comes into force after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order or on such date as the Authority certifies that the work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule to the order into a fit condition for use by the public, (whichever is the later), but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 1st April 2020, make an application to the High Court.
