Implementation and Monitoring

The purpose of this session is to examine the implementation and monitoring provisions of the LP.

Chapter 9 sets out how the LP will be implemented and monitored. Tables 7 and 8 include indicators and targets for implementation and monitoring.

Some modifications are proposed in response to Preliminary Questions.

Main Modifications MM128-143 are relevant to this matter.

Issues

1. Implementation and Monitoring Overall

Should para 9.2 provide more clarity as to the sources of information that will be available to measure the implementation of policies and ensure that infrastructure is delivered?

2. Indicators and Targets

Is the Council satisfied that the indicators for implementation and monitoring specific and measurable?

3. Housing Implementation Strategy

Do the indicators and targets and documents such as the Annual Monitoring Report form a firm basis for a Housing Implementation Strategy (paragraph 47 of the Framework refers)?

4. Review Mechanisms

Is the LP clear as to when a review of the Plan would be triggered due to a failure to meet key targets e.g. a persistent under delivery of housing?
